What: Green ergonomics: Designing a sustainable workplace

Who: Rosie O'Halloran, Ergonomist, University of Melbourne

Details: How do you gain a green star rating for ergonomic design? You can learn what's involved from Rosie O'Halloran, an award-winning Human Factors and Ergonomics practitioner, in her presentation to Central Safety Group on Tuesday 4 April. She will present a methodology she developed for evaluation and certification that led to her winning the 2022 University Safety Association's Safety Professional of the Year award.

Rosie says incorporating ergonomics and human factors principles and practice into the interior design of buildings comes down to three fundamental principles, and stakeholder engagement is key to getting it right. The outcome is work spaces that promote physical well-being and perceived environmental comfort.

While the credit rating requires certification by a Certified Professional Ergonomist, the method Rosie will outline offers a verified, quality benchmark that could be used with confidence by all safety personnel.

The rating is awarded by the Green Building Council of Australia for interior design that meets selected ergonomic criteria. It recognises the substantial health benefits of designing spaces and interfaces that provide optimum user comfort, safety and wellbeing and prevent or limit the risk of illness or injury.
