What: Working with the new psychosocial regulations

Who: Dr Natassia (Tas) Goode, Director, Psychological Health Division, WorkSafe Victoria

Details: Employers are now required to manage psychosocial risks like any other workplace safety hazard as a result of new workplace laws in Victoria. The long-anticipated Occupational Health and Safety (Psychological Health) Regulations 2025 came into effect on 1 December 2025.

Dr Natassia (Tas) Goode will discuss the new regulations and what they mean for both workers and employers in a presentation to CSG on Tuesday 14 April. She will outline what are classified as psychosocial hazards, and discuss how employers are expected to identify, assess and manage them.

The regulations apply to all Victorian employers, regardless of size, and cover employees, independent contractors and labour hire. Breaches attract penalties for both companies and individuals.

Dr Goode will be attending in person, so don't miss this opportunity to have the ear of the Regulator and have your questions answered about the regulations.
